

Asia-Pacific Mathematical Olympiad (APMOPS)

The Asia-Pacific Mathematical Olympiad (APMOPS) is organized by the Hwa-Chong Institution. The aim of this event is to promote a greater interest and love for Mathematics among students in schools. Anglo Singapore International School is the official hosting school for APMOPS in Bangkok.

Only participants born between 2nd January 2009 and 1st January 2010, both dates inclusive, or Primary 6 students under the UK grade system (final year of primary/elementary school) are eligible to take part in this year's competition. However, the student must not have participated in the competition previously.

This is a good opportunity for the students to gain exposure to the rigor of the Math Olympiad and pit their skills against other participants. APMOPS will award certificates based on the results of the participants. Selected top individual candidates during the first round may be invited to participate at the **Invitation Round** to be held at Hwa Chong Institution in Singapore.
