## <u>United Kingdom Mathematics Trust (UKMT) - Intermediate Mathematical Challenge (IMC)</u>

The United Kingdom Mathematics Trust (UKMT) - Intermediate Mathematical Challenge (IMC) is organized by ASEEDER (Seed International). Aiming to advance the education of children and young people in mathematics, last year the UKMT saw over 650,000 pupils take part in their three challenges (Junior, Intermediate, and Senior).

The problems on the Intermediate Mathematical Challenge are designed to make students think. It encourages mathematical reasoning, precision of thought, and fluency in using basic mathematical techniques to solve interesting problems. To recognize the highest performers in the Challenge, Top-Scoring Rules 50% of participants will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze in the ratio 1:2:3. International participants will be awarded based on the UK thresholds. Students not amongst the high scorers will receive a Certificate of Participation in E-version.

This is a good opportunity for the students to gain exposure to the rigour of the Math Olympiad in the United Kingdom and pit their skills against other participants around the world.
