The UKMT - Junior Mathematical Challenge (JMC) is organized by the ASEEDER (Seed International) and is Aiming to advance the education of children and young people in mathematics, last year, The UKMT saw over 650,000 pupils take part in their three challenges (Junior, Intermediate and Senior).

The problems on the Junior Mathematical Challenge are designed to make students think. It encourages mathematical reasoning, precision of thought, and fluency in basic mathematical techniques to solve interesting problems.

To recognize the highest performers in the Challenge, the top-scoring 50% of participants will be awarded Bronze, Silver and Gold certificates in a ratio of 1:2:3. International participants will be awarded based on the UK thresholds. Students not amongst the high scorers will receive a Certificate of Participation in E-version.
